Guidelines for Thesis

Honours students are responsible for choosing the general area for their graduating essays, and for securing a supervisor by the beginning of the term in which they plan to complete the thesis course. The three-credit thesis should be approximately 20-25 pages in length (double spaced) or an equivalent project as determined in coordination with the supervisor. Projects that do not adhere to this standard page limit/format must be approved by your supervisor.
